Normal club rules in relation to guests apply –see overleaf.

DISCLAIMER

Guest

You (the guest) hereby agree and acknowledge that you take part at your own risk and that the Club shall not be, nor be deemed to be, responsible or liable whether in contract or in tort or under any statute for:

(a) Any personal injury (including illness) which may be suffered by you or any damage sustained to your personal property whilst a day member, unless it arises as a direct result of a deliberate or wrongful act or omission of the club or as a result of its negligence; or

(b) Any other loss or damage suffered by you as a result of your use of the club facilities. Provided that nothing in this clause shall operate to exclude liability of the organiser for death or personal injury caused by its negligence.

You (the guest) agree to Trent Windsurfing Club holding your personal details in accordance with the GDPR regulations 2018. Trent Windsurfing Club will not pass your personal details to any other parties. You (the guest) agree to allow any photographs taken that might include you to be used, solely by TWC, for the purposes of publicity or promotion.

You (the guest) also confirm that you have read and fully understand the rules overleaf you agree to comply with them.

DAY MEMBERSHIP RULES

Please note:- There are two types of guest.

- **Those who are granted Day Membership by virtue of completing this form, and are then permitted full use of the club facilities and equipment or their own equipment.**
- **Visitors are not permitted to use any club equipment either on the water or on land, neither are they allowed to use their own equipment.**

1. A club member[‡] is permitted to invite no more than 2 guests either as Visitors[†] and/or Day Members at any one time, unless an exception is granted by the committee.
2. The club member may be liable to a sanction, up to and including membership revocation, if they do not ensure that a Day Membership form is completed by the guest before any equipment is used whether on the water or not.
3. Day Membership permits the guest to use the club equipment or their own equipment.
4. The inviting Club Member shall ensure that any Day Membership guests leave the premises before said member and on being the last to leave the club premises ensure that all club premises are locked and secured.
5. No launching and use of other craft other than windsurfers or paddle boards are permitted in the club water except for the purposes of training, rescue or maintenance authorised by the committee.
6. Members* are responsible for their own safety and the safety of any family members.
7. It is the responsibility of the inviting member to ensure the guest is competent to use the equipment which they choose to use unsupervised.
8. Members* are responsible for assessing the prevailing conditions and must not windsurf or SUP if conditions are unsuitable for their skill level.
9. Overnight stays by non-members are covered by the Club Bye Laws.
10. Vehicles belonging to non-members are parked entirely at the owners' risk.
11. Dogs must be kept under control on club premises and any mess caused to be cleaned up thoroughly.
12. No swimming is permitted in the club waters as an activity in its own right.
13. No child under the age of eighteen years shall be allowed onto the club premises or use the club water unless closely supervised by a parent or guardian. All children under the age of 18 MUST wear effective personal buoyancy provided by their parent/guardian.
14. A limit of two visits per guest per year is in force. After this limit, a membership must be applied for unless an exception is granted by the committee.
15. The club recommends that adequate personal buoyancy should be worn when on the water.
16. Anyone under instruction by a club instructor shall wear effective personal buoyancy when on the water.
17. Anyone under instruction by a club instructor shall comply with all instructions of said instructor or his/her assistant(s).
18. No member* shall deposit rubbish or leave litter on the club premises.

[‡] *A Family Membership counts as one Member in respect of number of Visitors/Guests permitted.*

[†] *Visitors are permitted under club Bye Laws and are NOT permitted to use any of the club equipment.*

* *Reference to members in this context includes day members.*
